KSKJ BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 Team, Singles, Doubles and All Events Championships to be decided on a Handicap basis. Twenty-five percent of the team prize money will be paid to the first place teams. Also, in lieu of team trophies, \$150 to be awarded for jackets. Jackets must bear **K.S.K.J.** The National Athletic Director will distribute Jacket allotment to the team captain. All singles, doubles and all events first place winners in each event will receive trophies in addition to cash prizes.

- There will be a maximum of 68 pins per game allowed.** Handicap will be 80% of the difference between 220 for men and 200 for women, based on the following: (1) Highest final average for the 2010-2011 season, 21-game minimum; (2) If contestant did not participate in that season, highest final average from the 2009-2010 season, 21-game minimum; (3) Current highest 21-game average as of Oct. 10, 2011. If contestant did not participate in any league, the previous tournament average may be used (if on record); (4) The 10 pin or more increase in average provision USBC 319a-2 will apply, effective Oct. 11, 2011; (5) If bowler has no established **sanctioned** average, then the men will use 165 and women will use 140.

- 3 It shall be a bowler's responsibility to verify his or her average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or to make a correction prior to, or up to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score or base prize winnings on submitted average if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.

- 4 A bowler may participate only once in each event. However, a bowler entered in the Team Event only and who has already bowled this event may substitute for an absent bowler in the Doubles Event only in case of an emergency.

- 5 A bowler must bowl both Doubles & Singles. There is no Doubles only or Singles only

- 6 Bowlers must be bona-fide members of KSKJ of any lodge in their respective communities. Any bowler participating under and assumed name, or who is not a member of KSKJ, forfeits all prize monies and entry fees. All participants **MUST** be verified by the lodge secretary of the Home Office.

- 7 USBC Rule 319a (tournament average adjustment) shall apply to all participants

- 8 USBC Rule 319d (reporting of prize winnings) shall not apply.

- 9 In a moral support sanctioned tournament, high score recognition is automatically extended to USBC members. Eligible non members can qualify for high score recognition at their option by paying a fee for which their local respective bowling congress will issue an unattached membership card.

- 10 Unmarried grade or high school students who have not attained the age of 18 shall have the written consent of their parents or guardian to participate in a USBC-sanctioned tournament where cash or merchandise prizes are offered. Said consent must be on a form approved by USBC and must be on file with the tournament secretary at least a week prior to the tournament, unless the student is accompanied by his parent or guardian, in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the student begins bowling. **ANY BOWLER WISHING TO PROTECT HIS OR HER AMATEUR STANDING (USBC) MAY NOT BOWL IN THIS TOURNAMENT.**

- 11 Unsportsman-like conduct on the lanes will not be permitted. If it persists after warning is given, it will result in refusal by the tournament committee to permit said individual(s) to participate in future tournaments.

- 12 Any participant(s) not complying with tournament rules will have his/her/their reservations canceled

- 13 No entry money returned after entries close. All entries will be received in accordance with the rules of the USBC and the KSKJ.

- 14 Scheduling will be governed by entry date and the Tournament Secretary will schedule events according to times requested by entrants, if possible; otherwise, scheduling will be at the discretion of the Tournament Secretary. All line-up changes must be made at least 30 minutes before the time the entrants are scheduled to bowl.
